GENERAL EVENT PRINCIPLES AND GUIDELINES

- Participation in the TLV 18 Hole Men's Club Tournaments and Thursday League is limited to members of the 18 Hole Men's Club.
- Tournament participants are allowed to play to a maximum course handicap of 36.
- Announce and clarify any local rules in effect and how ties will be broken. Each person/team should receive a copy of the events Rules Sheet.
- If ties are to be broken, they will be done according to USGA Rules. (See Article VII in bylaws)
- All TLV 18-Hole Men's Club Sponsored Events shall have a "Rules Committee" set up before the Event. This should include the VP, Tournament Chair and Handicap Chair.
- Awards for individual and team winners in any event must be purchased through the TLV Pro Shop, with the exception of Hole-In-One which will be paid in cash.
- Treasurer will pay the Pro Shop and Restaurant the day of the event.
- Refreshments and meals for the event should be purchased through the clubhouse restaurant. A written proposal, including menu and cost of the meal with tax and gratuity, must be obtained.
- Club Sponsored Events may be cancelled by agreement among the TLV Pro, Golf Superintendent, and Tournament Chair.
- Results, including payouts shall be submitted to Pro Shop staff for posting.
- Exceptions to these principles and guidelines must be approved prior to the Club Sponsored Event by the TLV Men's 18-hole Executive Board.

SPECIFIC TOURNAMENT/ EVENTS PRINCIPLES AND GUIDELINES

HOLE-IN-ONE

- Club dues will include \$5 for hole-in-one. Payout will happen at spring meeting.
- Players may enter at any time during the season. Hole-in-One eligibility starts when entry fee is paid.
- Hole-in-One can be at any time during the season. You must have one witness and it must be on the first shot.
- Must complete a minimum of 9 holes
- Must turn the scorecard in with the date & at least 2 signatures (player & witness) to the Pro Shop.
- If more than one Hole-In-One is made during the season, the fund will be split equally.

RYDER CUP

- This two-day team event will consist of two equally divided teams.
- The formats will be decided by the Executive Board.
- The morning of the first day of competition, the teams will be announced and formats reviewed.
- The results will be announced after play Sunday.
- All "General Event Principles and Guidelines" of the Club shall be followed.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

- To be eligible for the Club championship, a participant must have a GHIN handicap, be a member in good standing of the TLV Men's 18-hole Golf Club and have played in FIVE (5) club sponsored events: Thursday night league and/or club sponsored tournaments.
- Competition dates will be determined by the Executive Board.
- Two days determine the Club Champion and flight winners. The total of the two scores will be used for results.
- TLV Pro Shop, with input from the Executive Board, will organize-tee times, pairings and scoring of the Club Championship.
- Competition will be played in flights, which will be determined by the number of participants.
- On the second day of play individuals with the lowest gross scores shall play in the last two Pairings. All other players will be positioned in their flight per their gross score from the previous day.
- Ties for Club Champion will be determined by a 1-hole playoff. If no winner is determined, additional holes will be played until there is a winner (sudden death).
- Other ties will be broken by card off as described in Article VII in bylaws.
- Club Championship Awards
 - Club Champion Low Gross of Field
 - Remainder of Awards by flights
 - Awards will be Pro shop Credit
- All "General Event Principles and Guidelines" of the Club shall be followed.

PAYOUTS FOR TOURNAMENTS:

Payouts will be determined by number of participants as follows: 9% for all tournaments (\$30 entry) and 18% for club championship (\$60 entry) If upfront total not paid prior to due date. (May 1)
