

# TWIN LAKES VILLAGE (TLV) WOMEN'S 18-HOLE GOLF CLUB GUIDELINES FOR CLUB SPONSORED EVENTS

## GENERAL EVENT PRINCIPLES AND GUIDELINES

- Participation in the TLV 18 Hole Women's Club Tournaments except for Remembrance Day is limited to members of the 18 Hole Women's Club.
- Event chairs should work with the TLV Pro Shop to create pairings to establish equal speed of play throughout the field.
- Tee times and pairings are created using Golf Genius and are managed by the Pro Shop. Requests for changes are highly discouraged.
- Participants are allowed to play to a maximum course handicap of 40.
- Announce and clarify any local rules in effect – how “ties” will be broken. Each person/team should receive a copy of the “Event's Rules Sheet”.
- For weekly club play, ties will not be broken. Winnings will be shared.
- For all tournament play, if there is a tie, the winnings will be split among members who tied.
- For all weekly and tournament play, verify scores for each hole before proceeding to the next hole. Total scores for the front, back and total. Confirm totals before signing and turning in your card. Take a picture in the event there is a discrepancy with the posted score.
- All TLV 18-Hole Women's Club Sponsored Events shall have a “Rules Committee” set up before the Event. This should include the TLV Pro/Assistant Pro, Committee Chair and Handicap Chair (if available-at least 3).
- Awards for individual and team winners in any event must be purchased through the TLV Pro Shop, except for Hole-In-One, Club Championship and KPs.
- When purchasing T-Prizes, the Events Chair should give 1<sup>st</sup> option to the Pro Shop.
- Every attempt will be made to have a balanced budget for specific events.
- Tournament/Event chairs should be sent **within two weeks after play concludes**:
  - **2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President** - A list of the participants and score cards
  - **President and 1st Vice President** -The Special Tournament Reporting Form, participant list, results, and menu as applicable
  - **Treasurer** – Request for Funds or Reimbursements Form with receipts attached
- Refreshments and meals for the event should be purchased through the clubhouse restaurant. A written proposal, including menu and cost of the meal with tax and gratuity, must be obtained.
- Club Sponsored Events will only be cancelled if the Golf Course is closed.
- The 1st Vice President and the Tournament Chair, working with the TLV Pro Shop, shall provide for alternate play dates as required.
- Results, including payouts shall be submitted to Pro Shop staff for posting.
- Exceptions to these principles and guidelines must be approved prior to the Club Sponsored Event by the TLV Women's 18-hole Executive Board.

# **TWIN LAKES VILLAGE (TLV) WOMEN'S 18-HOLE GOLF CLUB GUIDELINES FOR CLUB SPONSORED EVENTS**

- The event shall be held over three days.
- The Friday evening event will review the formats and include an optional singles 9-hole game.
- This 2-day team match play format will consist of two equally divided teams.
- The results will be announced after play at Sunday's no host event. Awards will be presented at the EOY Banquet.
- All "General Event Principles and Guidelines" of the Club shall be followed.

## **Sweatshirt**

- The Event shall be held on a consecutive Tuesday and Wednesday, determined by the Executive Board.
- All participants must compete on both days. If a team member cannot play on the second day, the team members will compete without a substitute.
- Teams are created by the TLV Pro Shop in an effort to make teams as equal as possible.
- The number of teams recognized is based on the size of the field.
- All winners will receive Pro Shop Credit
- Awards will be presented at the EOY Banquet.
- All "General Event Principles and Guidelines" of the Club shall be followed.

## **Belle Ringer**

- The Event shall be held on a consecutive Tuesday and Wednesday, determined by the Executive Board.
- All participants must compete on both days. If a team member cannot play the second day, the remaining team member will compete without a substitute.
- The format is two-person teams where you pick your own partner. Scoring is eclectic. Tournament score will be the lowest net score of the team from the two days for each hole.
- The maximum stroke differential allowed is 10. If the differential is greater than 10, the higher handicapper must adjust to the 10-stroke difference.
- The number of teams recognized is based on the size of the field.
- All "General Event Principles and Guidelines" of the Club shall be followed.

## **18/9 HOLE WOMEN'S COMPETITION**

- Participants from the 18-Hole & 9-Hole Women's Club will host an annual Remembrance team competition. The Remembrance Celebration, honoring Club Members no longer with us will follow golf.
- Teams are created with the assistance of the TLV Pro Shop depending on the number of participants.

- Flights & winners will be determined by the number of participants.
- All “General Event Principles and Guidelines” of the Club shall be followed.

## **WOMEN'S 18-HOLE INVITATIONAL (Diamonds in The Rough)**

- TLV plays host to women throughout the region every other year.
- Pairings will be arranged by the TLV Pro Shop per Invitational Entry Form.
- A shotgun start shall be used.
- Format is individual stroke play with awards for Gross and Net.
- Lunch is served. WINNERS AND RESULTS ARE ANNOUNCED BY THE PRO SHOP.
- All “General Event Principles and Guidelines” of the Club shall be followed.

## **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**

- To be eligible for the Club championship, a participant must have a GHIN handicap, be a member in good standing of the TLV Women's 18-hole Golf Club and have played in (5) club sponsored events.
- Scores posted in any combination of the following will be counted toward the five required scores: Tuesday Play, Women's 18-Hole Tournament Days and Tuesdays of the NRGGA tournament.
- Competition dates will be determined by the Executive Board and published in the Yearbook.
- Two days determine the Club Champion and flight winners. The total of the two scores will be used for results.
- TLV Pro Shop, with input from the Executive Board, will organize tee times, pairings and scoring of the Club Championship. Once tee times are established, they will not be changed.
- On the first day of play, competition will be played in flights based on handicaps recorded on the last day of official club play and will be determined by the number of participants.
- On the second day of play individuals with the lowest gross scores shall play in the last two pairings. All other players will be positioned per their gross score from the previous day.
- The Club Championship will pay out as many places as possible.
- Each person will receive a copy of the Club Championship Rules, which includes local rules. If there is a tie for the gross club champion, the tie will be broken with a 3-hole playoff until a winner is determined. If there is a tie for low net of the field, the tie will be broken with a 1-hole playoff until a winner is determined.
- Practice before competition on the day of the tournament will result in disqualification.
- Club Championship Awards
  - Club Champion - Low Gross of Field
  - Low Net of the Field will receive a Pro Shop credit.
  - Remainder of Awards by flights

- Awards will be Pro shop credit.
- Awards will be presented at the EOY Banquet.
- This event is financially supported by member's dues.
- All "General Event Principles and Guidelines" of the Club shall be followed.

## **ACE OF THE MONTH/ACE OF THE YEAR**

- Ace of the Month will be played on either the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month (June, July, and August) depending on holidays & NRGGA. Gross winner and net winner of the field will be the Aces of the Month.
- A player may only win one time throughout the season-
- Before the end of the year meeting, these winners, both gross and net, will compete for the Ace of the Year awards.
- Pro Shop credit awards will be presented at the end-of-the-year Banquet.
- Ties for monthly Ace Day will be retained, and all winners will advance
- Ties for Ace of Aces will be a one-hole playoff for gross and net players until a winner is determined

## **NRGA**

- NRGGA is headed by a member(s) in good standing with the TLV 18- Hole Women's Club.
- The Chair(s)
  - Keep members informed of NRGGA events and dates.
  - Signs up players.
  - Sends required information in by deadline dates.
  - Is responsible for having the Treasurer pay the annual NRGGA Club Fee, and
  - Coordinates with the restaurant and Pro Shop when the tournament is held at Twin Lakes Village
